

**Comparison of "Cure Provision" Requirements for Existing Rule 520.6 and Amended Rule 520.6, effective May 18, 2011**

<b>Type of Program</b>	Certificate or LLM degree	LLM degree only
<b>Minimum Number of Credits</b>	20 credits	24 credits
<b>Program must be completed at an ABA-approved law school?</b>	Yes	Yes
<b>May coursework be completed at campus in a foreign country?</b>	No	No
<b>Summer Programs</b>	Not permitted	Not exclusively; maximum of 4 credits
<b>Accelerated Programs</b>	Not permitted	Not permitted
<b>Courses require classroom instruction?</b>	Yes	Yes
<b>General Coursework</b>	Courses must be in "professional law subjects"	Courses shall be in classroom courses in substantive and procedural law and professional skills
<b>Required Courses</b>	Must include at least 2 courses in "basic American law."	(a) minimum of 2 credits in professional responsibility/legal ethics; (b) minimum of 2 credits in legal research, writing & analysis; (c) minimum of 2 credits in American legal studies, American legal system or similar course; (d) minimum of 6 credits in other courses tested on the NY bar exam.
<b>Clinical Courses</b>	Not permitted	Yes; maximum of 4 credits
<b>Courses related to legal training taught by faculty at law school or affiliated school.</b>	Not permitted	Yes; maximum of 6 credits provided courses completed at campus located within the U.S.
<b>Restrictions on length of program</b>	No	Yes; LLM must be completed within 24 months of matriculation
<b>Restrictions on number of semesters</b>	No	Yes; must be a minimum of two non-summer semesters of at least 13 weeks each exclusive of reading periods, examinations & breaks
<b>Distance or Correspondence Study</b>	Not permitted	Not permitted
<b>On-line coursework</b>	Not permitted	Not permitted
