The New York State Board of Law Examiners announced today that grading has been

completed for the July 2019 New York State Bar Examination. Candidates received electronic

notification of their examination results today.

The passing rate for graduates of American Bar Association accredited law schools who

took the bar examination for the first time in July 2019 is 86%, an increase of 3% from the July

2018 examination. The passing rate for graduates of New York law schools who took the bar

examination in July 2019 for the first time is 85%, which is an increase of 4% from last year.

The Board examined a total of 10,071 candidates, including U. S. domestic-educated

candidates and foreign-educated candidates, first-time and repeat takers, during the two days of

testing conducted on July 30-31, 2019, an increase of 392 candidates from last year. Of those

candidates, 6,536 passed for an overall passing rate of 65%, which is 2% higher than last year's

overall passing rate of 63%.

The passing rate for all foreign-educated candidates who sat for the July 2019

examination is 43%. The number of foreign-educated candidates who sat for the bar

examination in July was a record 3,559, or 35% of all candidates who sat for the July

examination.

A list of candidates passing the July 2019 bar examination will be available to the public on the Board's website at www.nybarexam.org after 9:00 am Eastern on Thursday, October 24, 2019. Each successful candidate, who also has completed the New York Law Course and taken and passed both the New York Law Exam and the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination as required by the Rules of the New York State Court of Appeals, will be certified by the Board to the Appellate Division for admission to the bar. Each candidate must then appear before the Committee on Character and Fitness to be examined as to his or her character and fitness before being admitted to the bar.

The Board congratulates the candidates who were successful on the July 2019 bar examination.
